

- 9:00 pm Night prayer

- Playing cards with a blind man!



History of the Mission

Through the invitation of His Excellency, Most Rev. Peter J. Jugis, Bishop of Charlotte, MOP MONROE becomes the first international mission established by the Missionaries of the Poor in the United States of America. Together with four Brothers assigned to set up the mission, the Very Rev. Fr. Richard Ho Lung, M.O.P., Founder and Superior General of the Institute traveled on the Feast of the Guardian Angels, October 2, 2008 to officially establish the Institute's footing in Monroe North Carolina (see photo on right).

- All of us, <u>as IHM</u>, collected and transported supplies and \$ to help brothers care for the blind, the homeless...
